10.10	<p>Hello game*, <a href="#">Aslan Prayer</a></p> <p>Two big questions a lot of people ask are – ‘Is there a God’ and ‘How did the earth and all the other planets come into existence?’ Christians believe that the Bible gives us answers to those questions. At the beginning of the Bible, it says that God created the world in 7 days. While he could have done that in literally 7 days, most people think of it as a period of time. Somewhere else in the Bible (2 Pet 3:8) it says that ‘One day is like a thousand years to God’, so how long it all took is not as important as remembering that God is the great creator of the whole of our natural world. Let’s watch a video which explains the order that things were created in. Video - <a href="#">Creation (Genesis 1-2)</a></p> <p>Let’s see if you can remember the order of creation. We’ll watch this song and see if you can tell me afterwards what happened on each day: Creation Song <a href="#">Creation Song</a> 1 light, day and night (he created the first day) 2 sky – space between heaven and earth 3 sea, land, plants and trees 4 stars, sun and moon 5 birds, fish, dolphins, whales 6 animals, humans 7 God rested</p> <p>Another song that reminds us how very powerful God is: <a href="#">My God is so big and so strong and so mighty</a></p> <p>Prayer time</p> <p>As we have our snack, let’s watch a video of amazing images taken of the universe by the Hubble Telescope.</p>	<p>Ball for game*</p> <p>Words of prayer on screen</p> <p>Videos</p>
